



JOBY CARTER'S FANCY LETTERING AND FAIRGROUND ART COURSE

This action-packed weekend offers a rare opportunity to learn about the secretive craft of fairground painting, including fancy lettering, block lettering, understanding shadows, the 3D effect, blending, lining, scrolls and much more. This course features advanced painting techniques and is best suited to people who have experience of signwriting already.

If you want to learn and have a go at signwriting, we recommend you come on one of our 5-day courses first.

WHERE IS THE COURSE?

The course is held in Joby's paintshop at the Carters Steam Fair Yard, in White Waltham near Maidenhead.

WHAT TIME IS THE COURSE ON?

This course runs from 9am till 5pm, please arrive promptly at 8.45am on the first day and 9am on the second day as it's an action-packed course.

DO I NEED TO BRING ANYTHING?

All materials are provided for the duration of the course excluding gold leaf. You can buy your own equipment at the end of the weekend. Please wear old clothes that you don't care about - you will get painty!

WHERE CAN I STAY?

There are plenty of places to stay nearby including the Holiday Inn Maidenhead about 3.5 miles away. (020 334 991 69) and a Kate Goughs B&B in Innings Lane, White Waltham (01628 826 789). There is also an Air B&B nearby which is a 10-minute walk. Simply search 'White Waltham' on the Air B&B website. There is a countryside hotel about 3.5 miles away called the Bird in Hand (01628 627 461) Unfortunately, we cannot provide space for caravans or mobile homes in the Yard; it's a busy working fairground yard and we are moving vehicles around a lot. Other guests have recommended visiting the Cookham Lock Campsite (03708 506 506) which is a 24-minute drive, or you'll find others on the Caravan Club website.
